



COUNTRY ASSIGNMENTS

The table below includes all countries represented at HMUN India 2017 in the General Assembly (GA), Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), and Specialized Agencies (SA). All relevant committees are listed below. All 193 United Nations member-states are represented in General Assembly committees. Each country corresponds to an individual that will be assigned with the allocation. Delegations range in size from 1 to 15 delegates, and more than one delegation may be assigned to a school. Allocation of positions within the World Social Forum, an ECOSOC committee, may be roughly correlated to your country allocation (see page 6 for a list of WSF positions). Special applications for the Iraq Revolutionary Command Council and the Press Corps are available and will be due on April 28, 2017. Committees labeled with a (2) are double delegation committees. Allocations to these committees will only be made in pairs. Country assignments are completed at the discretion of the Secretariat, and all allocations are final.
